

Two indicted in murder, kidnapping

A grand jury indicted two people Friday on murder and kidnapping charges in the slaying of two Las Vegas men whose buried bodies were found last month near Lake Mead's Callville Bay.

Mamie Peot, 28, and Richard Hinger, 57, each face two counts of murder with a deadly weapon and two counts of first-degree kidnapping in the deaths of James Sorenson, 27, and Scott Rehn, 40.

Both suspects are being held without bail at the Clark County Detention Center. They must appear Wednesday for an arraignment before District Judge Donald Mosley.

Cameron Carlow, 21, also faces two counts of being an accessory to murder. Police arrested the three suspects shortly after the May 10 discovery of the bodies, and authorities released Carlow May 28 on his own recognizance.

Police said they believe the victims were fatally shot around Feb. 19 during a disagreement at a trailer park in the 3700 block of East Lake Mead Boulevard.
