

Burley man found dead

A Burley man's body was one of two found buried Tuesday near Las Vegas.

Las Vegas authorities have charged one man and expect to file more charges against others in the alleged double murder.

According to Sgt. Bill Keeton of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police's Homicide Division, the remains of Scott Rehn, 40, Burley, were found buried along with a Jimmy Sorensen in the Lake Meade National Monument in Nevada May 10.

Rehn and Sorensen were report-

edly shot to death in a Feb. 19 argument in Las Vegas in a Las Vegas trailer.

Coroner reports indicate Rehn was shot with a shotgun in the right shoulder and forearm and was then killed by suffocation soon after the shooting.

Richard Hainger, 57, Las Vegas, was arrested and charged in connection with the shooting.

Rehn had been reported missing since Feb. 19. Officers followed an anonymous tip and were led to the burial scene.

Keeton declined to comment on the nature of the argument.
